## Community Shares Announces COSMO Award Ceremony Recipients

**Columbus, OH** – Community Shares of Mid Ohio (CoSMO) held their second annual COSMO Award Ceremony on Wednesday, August 12 at 5:00 p.m. at the Ohio Statehouse Atrium. The award ceremony recognized individuals and organizations in Central Ohio that have made a significant contribution to building a stronger community.

The COSMO Workplace Campaign Award was given to a CoSMO participating employer that has distinguished itself by encouraging its employees to participate in CoSMO campaigns. The 2009 recipient was Worthington City Schools, who was recognized for the expansion of their workplace giving campaign to include Community Shares and its member agencies, increasing the range of giving options for their employees and their support of local, community based non-profits.

The COSMO Sonya Mawhorter Volunteer Award was given to an individual who has actively contributed to CoSMO in a significant and positive way. The Volunteer Award is named for Sonya Mawhorter, a board representative for the Ohio League for the Mentally Retarded, who passed away in 2008. The 2009 recipient was Jeff Whiting, board representative for Kaleidoscope Youth Center, for his leadership as Chair of the Communications Committee and service as CoSMO Board Secretary.

The COSMO Public Service Award was given to an individual who has encouraged the participation of public sector employees in CoSMO campaigns. The 2009 recipient was Michele Bondurant, who was recognized for her leadership of The Ohio State University “Bucks For Charity” Community Charitable Drive which for several years under Bondurant’s direction has raised over \$1 million annually for local nonprofits through the generosity of OSU employees.

The COSMO Reporting Award was for the best media coverage in Central Ohio about social justice issues. Nominations can be for individuals, specific news stories or news organizations in print, radio, television or the Internet. The 2009 recipient was Simply Living and WCRS, who was recognized for providing and encouraging local community programming. Their shows provide representation for under-served and under-represented people and viewpoints.

The COSMO Member of the Year Award was given to the CoSMO member organization that has made the most notable and significant contributions to building a stronger local community. The 2009 recipient was CASA of Franklin County. For 18 years, CASA has provided powerful volunteer advocates for 737 abused and neglected children, strengthening families and assuring these children a safe and permanent home. Fewer than 4 percent of children served by CASA re-enter the system.

CASA takes on the most difficult cases including children who have been sexually and physically abused, newborns to 3 years of age with multiple issues, and children who have witnessed domestic violence in the home. CASA's volunteer based GAL program is the only way for community members to get involved in the juvenile court system. These are everyday volunteers practicing social justice by making a difference ....one child at a time.

“Central Ohio has so many generous donors and volunteers. We are delighted with this opportunity to recognize those who have contributed to strong, healthy communities,” said Community Shares Executive Director Melissa Magers.

Nominees were submitted by board members of Community Shares of Mid Ohio. The board's workplace campaign committee selected the winners from the submitted nominees.

With 16 years of success in workplace fundraising including annual double digit growth, Community Shares of Mid Ohio assists local area non-profits in new options to receive donations. Through workplace fundraising drives done in public and private sector workplaces, employees are given the opportunity to donate directly to the non-profit agencies they care about most through payroll contributions.
